Discussion Questions (30 – 40 minutes)

Q1. Explain what you think it means to seek God.

Q2. What do you think it means to have a relationship with God? What does it look like?

Q3. Why do you think God wants to have a relationship with you?

Read Matthew 7:24-27

Q4. What are some of the storms in your life?

Q5. Do you think God intentionally puts us through trials?

Q6. Isn't there an easier way to learn?

Q7. Have you ever felt like God failed to come through for you? What happened? Do you feel the same now?

Q8. Do you ever act like things are okay when they're not? Why do you think we do this?

Read 1 Jeremiah 29:11-14a

Q9. When you're going through really hard times and everything seems hopeless, do you still trust that God knows the way and that you're going to make it?

Q10. God promises us that if we seek him, he will be found by us. Are you ready to seek God in your life? How do you plan to seek him?

Q11. If you want to seek God, then tell him you want to find him. Ask him to put a desire for him deep within your heart.

Matthew 7:24-27 (NIV)

24"Therefore everyone who hears these words of mine and puts them into practice is like a wise man who built his house on the rock. 25The rain came down, the streams rose, and the winds blew and beat against that house; yet it did not fall, because it had its foundation on the rock. 26But everyone who hears these words of mine and does not put them into practice is like a foolish man who built his house on sand. 27The rain came down, the streams rose, and the winds blew and beat against that house, and it fell with a great crash."
