### *Discussion Questions...*

Q1. What standards do you have about the type of girl you want to date and eventually marry?

### *Read Matt 5:27-32*

Q3. Explain what you think it means for a person's heart be corrupted by lust. Why do you think Jesus places so much importance on this?

Q4. One of the major pitfalls for guys is pornography. What is it about pornography that is so dangerous?

### *Read 1 Corinthians 9:24-27*

Q5. Everywhere you look whether it's in the magazine racks, the TV, movies, music or even billboards we are bombarded by sexual images and sexual language that is immoral and/or suggestive. As a guy with a billion hormones raging around in your body, how can you protect your beliefs about sex that come from God from getting distorted by the world?

Q6. Paul talks about training yourself spiritually as an elite athlete trains himself for the Olympic Games. How can you train yourself spiritually when it comes to the issue of lust?

Q7. What steps can you take to become the type of person who views girls the way God views them?

### *Discussion Questions...*

Q1. Have you ever thought about what sort of guy you would allow yourself to date before? Do you have a list of standards that must be met before you will date someone?

Q2. Why do you think it is so important for a girl to have high standards when it comes to dating?

Q3. Take some time and discuss as a group what standards you have or should have for a possible dating relationship. Make a list of character and spiritual qualities you think are important in a possible boyfriend that would help protect you and your relationship with God.

Q5. What do you think about the lust for emotional intimacy? Have you ever thought about it before? Has it ever played a part in your life?

Q6. What is your plan to not fall into the trap of lusting for emotional intimacy?

### *Digging Deeper – A Reflection on Emotional Lust*

When people talk about lust, they usually associate it with guys – and rightly so. Lust is a huge struggle for every red-blooded guy on the planet. However, girls also fall prey to lust – some to a physical lust like boys, but most to a lust for companionship and emotional intimacy. One of the greatest fears for girls is that they will be alone and that no one (particularly guys) will want them. It is amazing what a girl will give up (including her beliefs and

faith) for a relationship with a guy. This type of lust is even more destructive than physical lust because it's so much more destructive to one's faith. Lusting for emotional intimacy with a guy has been the cause of more girls giving up their virginity, their faith and their own self-respect than any other sin. In almost every case, a girl who chooses to date a guy who does not share her spiritual convictions and beliefs (or a guy who says he does, but whose actions say otherwise) will end up compromising her beliefs to stay in the relationship. In fact, it is only the exception where this does not happen (thus the excuse "but I know so-and-so did and their boyfriend became a Christian"). Unfortunately, almost every girl believes she and her boyfriend are the exception, and the stats are staggering when it comes to girls leaving behind their faith for a guy.
