Q4. Why does Paul call all the things mentioned in Galatians “fruit”?

Q5. What does it mean to “crucify” the flesh?

Q6. What does it mean to “live by the Spirit”?

Q7. What is so important about having this “fruit” in your life?

Q8. Which fruits do you think you need a lot of help with? What step can you take to see this fruit start to grow in your life?

### **Bible Passages for Fusion Discussion**

#### **Today's Ephesians Passage (4:1-6... ESV)**

<sup>4</sup>I therefore, a prisoner for the Lord, urge you to walk in a manner worthy of the calling to which you have been called, <sup>2</sup>with all humility and gentleness, with patience, bearing with one another in love, <sup>3</sup>eager to maintain the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace. <sup>4</sup>There is one body and one Spirit—just as you were called to the one hope that belongs to your call— <sup>5</sup>one Lord, one faith, one baptism, <sup>6</sup>one God and Father of all, <sup>6</sup>who is over all and through all and in all.

#### **Galatians 5:22-26 (ESV)**

<sup>22</sup>But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, <sup>23</sup>gentleness, self-control; against such things there is no law. <sup>24</sup>And those who belong to Christ Jesus have crucified the flesh with its passions and desires.

<sup>25</sup>If we live by the Spirit, let us also keep in step with the Spirit. <sup>26</sup>Let us not become conceited, provoking one another, envying one another.
