# Born to Sail 3 - The Code

### Main Texts: Exodus 20; Matt 22:34-40; Matt 5:17-20

**The point:** God made the law, not to save us, but rather to point us toward Jesus.

#### Intro:

Review:

- ⇒ We were born to sail
- ⇒ The curse why are we all cursed? (Gen 3 & Gal 3:10)
- ⇒ The wages of sin is death... Rom 6:23 (God's warning was that disobedience would bring death)

## The CODE – Beginnings...

Movie Clip... *Pirates of the Caribbean* [0.37.30 – 0.41.01]

- ⇒ God's first step to repair what was broken by man's sin in the garden of Eden was to promise that he would send a Saviour that would bridge the gap between us and him
- ⇒ He promised this Adam, then to Noah, and then to Abraham. It would be through Abraham's descendants that the Saviour would come.
- ⇒ God chose Abraham's descendants to be his people the people we now know as Israel
- ⇒ Israel becomes slaves of the Egyptians for 400 years until God sends Moses to deliver them
- ⇒ God gives Moses the 10 commandments as well as many other laws for his people to follow

#### **Read Exodus 20**

### The CODE - on Steroids...

- ⇒ skip ahead to the 1<sup>st</sup> century
- ⇒ The righteousness of Scribes and Pharisees
- ⇒ Righteousness means "right living"

### Read Matthew 5:17-20

⇒ Pharisees and Scribes were religious superstars

- ⇒ The only way you can exceed the righteousness of Pharisees is through Christ
- ⇒ Obeying the law does not make us right with God (Gal 2:20-21)... all our acts of righteousness are like filthy rags! (Is. 64:6)
- ⇒ The law was never meant to save us... it acts like an MRI machine to show us what's wrong with us
- ⇒ Only Christ gives us access to God
- ⇒ Rom 3 (from fusion q's last week)... no one is good, not even one.

#### The CODE – it's about the heart...

⇒ Sermon on the Mount – Jesus continually dismantles the Pharisees because he can see through their flimsy brand of righteousness

### Read Matthew 22:34-40

- ⇒ The heart of the Law has always been there that is why Jesus says that not the stroke of a pen will disappear.
- ⇒ The 10 commandments teach us how to love God and how to love each other but at the very heart of everything is this thing called love. It's all that matters and it's the bottom line!
