- Q1. Do you have hope? Where does it come from? What is it?
- Q2. What is your greatest fear about evangelism (sharing the story of Jesus)?
- Q3. Think about your circle of influence (family, friends, teachers, co-workers, bosses, etc). How do you think God wants you to impact the lives of these people?

***Read 2 Corinthians 4***

- Q4. Make a list of 3-5 people who you are in contact with every week who don't know Jesus. Tell God that you want to be available to him to draw these people closer to him. Put this list somewhere where you'll see it every day so you keep praying!

***Discussion Ender ...***

Take about 15 minutes (or however long it takes) a get your students to pray for one of their friends they want to become Christians. Show them how to use the text we just read to pray – their friends need to be able to see!

**BIBLE TEXTS****2 Corinthians 4:1-5**

Therefore, since God in his mercy has given us this new way, we never give up. <sup>2</sup>We reject all shameful deeds and underhanded methods. We don't try to trick anyone or distort the word of God. We tell the truth before God, and all who are honest know this. <sup>3</sup>If the Good News we preach is hidden behind a veil, it is hidden only from people who are perishing. <sup>4</sup>Satan, who is the god of this world, has blinded the minds of those who don't believe. They are unable to see the glorious light of the Good News. They don't understand this message about the glory of Christ, who is the exact likeness of God. <sup>5</sup>You see, we don't go around preaching about ourselves. We preach that Jesus Christ is Lord, and we ourselves are your servants for Jesus' sake. <sup>6</sup>For God, who said, "Let there be light in the darkness," has made this light shine in our hearts so we could know the glory of God that is seen in the face of Jesus Christ.
