# **FUSION Q's...** Relationships that Honour God 3: Beware the Bait!

#### Discussion Starter ...

Ask the students how their week went. Are there things your students want to pray about?

## Discussion Questions ...

- Q1. What stood out to you from the talk tonight?
- Q2. How does seeing sin as bait on a hook change the way you think about sin and what the world has to offer?
- Q3. Think about what bait Satan offers you in order to lead you away from God and fall into sin. What "bait" is Satan using to entice (tempt) you to sin?

#### Read James 1:12-18

- Q4. What is the reward for the person who remains standing when there is hardship?
- Q5. According to James what causes us to sin?
- Q6. Are there areas/desires in your life that giving birth to sin? How can you fight against them (avoid taking the bait)?
- Q7. What does James means when he says that God never casts a "shifting shadow"?

[Leader: a shifting shadow is untrustworthy as it is always changing unlike God who is completely trustworthy and good. Application – we do need to guess about what is good because he gave us his word to live by]

- Q8. How does knowing that God is good, trustworthy, and that we are God's "prized possession" affect the way we look at sin and what God says about it?
- Q9. Why do you think it is so hard to trust that God knows what he is talking about when it comes to sex?

[Leaders: God designed the gift of sex for marriage but Satan uses it as bait to catch us and destroy us]

### **Bible Passages for Fusion Discussion**

## James 1:12-18 (p. 735)

<sup>12</sup> God blesses those who patiently endure testing and temptation. Afterward they will receive the crown of life that God has promised to those who love him. <sup>13</sup> And remember, when you are being tempted, do not say, "God is tempting me." God is never tempted to do wrong, and he never tempts anyone else. <sup>14</sup> Temptation comes from our own desires, which entice us and drag us away. <sup>15</sup> These desires give birth to sinful actions. And when sin is allowed to grow, it gives birth to death.

<sup>16</sup> So don't be misled, my dear brothers and sisters. <sup>17</sup> Whatever is good and perfect comes down to us from God our Father, who created all the lights in the heavens, He never changes or casts a shifting shadow. <sup>18</sup> He chose to give birth to us by giving us his true word. And we, out of all creation, became his prized possession.
