

## **FUSION Q's... Holiness Part 4: Life Apprentices**

### ***Discussion Questions***

Q1. The devil is a thief and liar whose main purpose of existence is to deceive and destroy what God has built and is trying to build.

Why do you think people tend to trust the ways of the thief over the ways of God when we know the devil is a liar?

Q2. In what areas do you think you have been looking for life in all the wrong places?

Q3. Why do you think people search for life in the wrong places?

### ***Read Romans 6:5-11***

Q4. Why are we no longer slaves to sin when we become a Christian?

Q5. What does “when we died with Christ” mean? Why is it significant?

Q6. How is it possible to be dead to the power of sin? Does that mean we don't sin any more? Why or why not?

### ***Read Romans 6:12-14***

Q7. Why should we not let sin control the way we live? What is so bad about sin?

Q8. There are only 2 options: either we are allowing sin to control the way we live or we are allowing God to control the way we live. What is controlling the way you live?

Q9. What does it mean to “live under the freedom of God's grace”?

Q10. How can living in God's freedom change the way you live your life?

### **Bible Passages for Fusion Discussion**

#### **Romans 6:5-11 (NLT)**

5 Since we have been united with him in his death, we will also be raised to life as he was. 6 We know that our old sinful selves were crucified with Christ so that sin might lose its power in our lives. We are no longer slaves to sin. 7 For when we died with Christ we were set free from the power of sin. 8 And since we died with Christ, we know we will also live with him. 9 We are sure of this because Christ was raised from the dead, and he will never die again. Death no longer has any power over him. 10 When he died, he died once to break the power of sin. But now that he lives, he lives for the glory of God. 11 So you also should consider yourselves to be dead to the power of sin and alive to God through Christ Jesus.

#### **Romans 6:12-14 (NLT)**

12 Do not let sin control the way you live; do not give in to sinful desires. 13 Do not let any part of your body become an instrument of evil to serve sin. Instead, give yourselves completely to God, for you were dead, but now you have new life. So use your whole body as an instrument to do what is right for the glory of God. 14 Sin is no longer your master, for you no longer live under the requirements of the law. Instead, you live under the freedom of God's grace.
