

Relationships that Honour God 5: No Other Gods Part 2 – God’s Junk Box

Discussion Starter

Ask the students how their week went. Are there things your students want to pray about?

Discussion Questions

Q1. Pastor Chris said the Bible talks about sexual immorality as “God’s junk box” of sexual sin and sinful lust. Explain what sexual immorality is.

Q2. Pastor Chris talked about lust being desire and that there are 2 kinds – one sinful and one honouring to God. Explain the difference between the two.

Q3. Why do you think our culture is not willing to wait for sexual things until marriage?

Q4. In the Ephesians passage we read at Ignite it said that there should not be even a hint of sexual immorality in people who say they belong to Jesus (are Christians). Why does God see sexual immorality as being so bad?

Read 1 John 2:15-17

Q5. What kinds of things does the world offer us (list specific examples that we experience every day)?

Q6. Why should we not love the things the world offers us?
[Leader: remember the talk on sin as bait – the world is offering us bait]

Q7. What does John mean when he says this world is fading away?

Q8. What is the outcome of living a life that honours God?

Q9. What sort of things in your life are things of the world that you crave/love? What do you need to do to change this?

Bible Passages for Fusion Discussion

1 John 2:15-17 (p. 743)

¹⁵ Do not love this world nor the things it offers you, for when you love the world, you do not have the love of the Father in you. ¹⁶ For the world offers only a craving for physical pleasure, a craving for everything we see, and pride in our achievements and possessions. These are not from the Father, but are from this world. ¹⁷ And this world is fading away, along with everything that people crave. But anyone who does what pleases God will live forever.
