#### **Discussion Questions**

Q1. How specifically do you believe life arose on this earth? Explain why you believe this to be true and how much you have investigated your belief.

Q2. Why do you think the theory of evolution is so popular even though there is no conclusive evidence of the origin of life?

Q3. In your personal opinion what is the most appealing part about believing the evolutionary theory of how life began?

### Read Psalm 19:1-6

Q4. The Bible is very clear that God created the earth and that earth itself is continual on-going evidence of this. What is the most appealing part about believing that God created life?

Q5. In what way has being taught evolution in school affected your outlook toward God?

Q6. If the battle between Creation and evolution is a battle of competing belief systems (not science vs. religion) then why do you think evolution is taught in school as "scientific and factual" but creation is not?

Q7. If God created life, how should that knowledge affect the way you life your life?

#### Psalm 19:1-6 (NIV)

- <sup>1</sup> The heavens declare the glory of God; the skies proclaim the work of his hands.
- <sup>2</sup> Day after day they pour forth speech; night after night they display knowledge.
- <sup>3</sup> There is no speech or language where their voice is not heard.
- <sup>4</sup> Their voice goes out into all the earth, their words to the ends of the world. In the heavens he has pitched a tent for the sun,
- <sup>5</sup> which is like a bridegroom coming forth from his pavilion, like a champion rejoicing to run his course.
- <sup>6</sup> It rises at one end of the heavens and makes its circuit to the other; nothing is hidden from its heat.
