Discussion Starter ...

Ask the students how their week went. Are there things your students want to pray about?

Discussion Questions (30 – 40 minutes)

- Q1. What do you think love is (define it), and where do you get this idea from?
- Q2. Why do you think our culture emphasizes love as an emotion/feeling?
- Q3. Who do you think should have the final say on what love really is? Explain.

Read 1 Corinthians 13:1-8

- Q4. Why do you think love is such an important thing in the Bible?
- Q5. This passage describes what loves does or what it looks like. What parts of this passage are hard for you to accept? Explain.

- Q6. We often here about people "falling out of love", but the Bible says that love never fails. How can this be?
- Q7. What do you think is your greatest "take-away" from tonight's talk and/or discussion?
- Q8. Has your view of what love is changed? Why or why not?

Bible Passages for Fusion Discussion

1 Cor 13:1-8 (NIV)

If I speak in the tongues of men or of angels, but do not have love, I am only a resounding gong or a clanging cymbal. If I have the gift of prophecy and can fathom all mysteries and all knowledge, and if I have a faith that can move mountains, but do not have love, I am nothing. If I give all I possess to the poor and give over my body to hardship that I may boast, but do not have love, I gain nothing.

⁴Love is patient, love is kind. It does not envy, it does not boast, it is not proud. ⁵ It does not dishonor others, it is not self-seeking, it is not easily angered, it keeps no record of wrongs. ⁶ Love does not delight in evil but rejoices with the truth. ⁷ It always protects, always trusts, always hopes, always perseveres.

⁸ Love never fails.
