

## FUSION Q's... Daniel 6 – The Power to Save

### *Discussion Questions*

- Q1. What stood out for you in the talk today?
- Q2. Where do you struggle the most to follow Jesus and live a life that pleases him (eg. Home, school, friends, family, etc.)? Why is this? How can you change this?
- Q3. We have learned over and over about God's incredible power to save in the book of Daniel. How has this affected the way you understand who God is?
- Read John 15:18-21**
- Q4. Have you ever risked something (friendships, popularity, ridicule, relationships, sports, etc.) to honour God? Was it hard? What was the outcome?
- Q5. What is the risk of choosing not to honour God?
- Q6. Where does our courage come from to live for Jesus (stand out) rather than conform to the world's standards?
- Q7. Where did Daniel's courage come from? Can you have this same courage?

*Note: Daniel did not go to church, did not have youth group, did not have a bible, etc. What did he have that made him so courageous? A real relationship with a living God, an understanding of who God is, and faith in him and his power to save.*

### **Bible Passages for Fusion Discussion**

#### **John 15:18-21 (NLT)**

<sup>18</sup>“If the world hates you, remember that it hated me first. <sup>19</sup>The world would love you as one of its own if you belonged to it, but you are no longer part of the world. I chose you to come out of the world, so it hates you. <sup>20</sup>Do you remember what I told you? ‘A slave is not greater than the master.’ Since they persecuted me, naturally they will persecute you. And if they had listened to me, they would listen to you. <sup>21</sup>They will do all this to you because of me, for they have rejected the one who sent me.
