### The Quest for Eternal Life – The Path of God

#### What's Up? ...

Ask the students how their week went. Are there things your students want to pray about? Get them to pray for each other.

**Discussion Starter...** Would you rather lick a metal flagpole when it's -20 or do 10 laps around your school in nothing but a speedo or bikini with everyone watching when it's -20?

- Q1. What was your biggest takeaway from tonight's message?
- Q2. What is faith? How does it affect you?
- Q3. What does it mean to "keep your eyes on Jesus", and why is this so important?
- Q4. What do you think your greatest obstacle to faith is (what makes it most difficult to believe)?
- Read Gal 3:5-14**
- Q5. What do you think the "message of Christ" is? What happens to us when we believe this message?
- Q6. If we are trying to impress God or gain his acceptance by doing good things and obeying him, Paul says that we are cursed. Why would he say this?
- Q7. How is obeying God through faith different than obeying him to earn his acceptance?
- Q8. What is the blessing Abraham received (see v.14)? What is the significance of receiving this blessing?

## BIBLE TEXTS

### *Gal 3:5-14 (NLT)*

<sup>5</sup> I ask you again, does God give you the Holy Spirit and work miracles among you because you obey the law? Of course not! It is because you believe the message you heard about Christ.

<sup>6</sup> In the same way, "Abraham believed God, and God counted him as righteous because of his faith." <sup>7</sup> The real children of Abraham, then, are those who put their faith in God.

<sup>8</sup> What's more, the Scriptures looked forward to this time when God would make the Gentiles right in his sight because of their faith. God proclaimed this good news to Abraham long ago when he said, "All nations will be blessed through you." <sup>9</sup> So all who put their faith in Christ share the same blessing Abraham received because of his faith.

<sup>10</sup> But those who depend on the law to make them right with God are under his curse, for the Scriptures say, "Cursed is everyone who does not observe and obey all the commands that are written in God's Book of the Law." <sup>11</sup> So it is clear that no one can be made right with God by trying to keep the law. For the Scriptures say, "It is through faith that a righteous person has life." <sup>12</sup> This way of faith is very different from the way of law, which says, "It is through obeying the law that a person has life."

<sup>13</sup> But Christ has rescued us from the curse pronounced by the law. When he was hung on the cross, he took upon himself the curse for our wrongdoing. For it is written in the Scriptures, "Cursed is everyone who is hung on a tree." <sup>14</sup> Through Christ Jesus, God has blessed the Gentiles with the same blessing he promised to Abraham, so that we who are believers might receive the promised Holy Spirit through faith.
